



- All components flooring, joists, structural floor beams, perimeter rimboards, hangers and fixings are included in the design.


## CoreClad Textured ACQtreated plywood cladding:

The popularity of this product has exceeded all expectations, and regular shipments of the 2,440mm, 2,745mm and 3,050mm lengths are constantly improving stock levels.



#### MultiStrut floor beams:

240mm and 300mm are in good supply, with key lengths carried in stock.

### **Commonwealth Games** success and more


The Commonwealth Games was a great success, and we've seen some incredible results from IBuilt alums.
